### First Subtitle (Give a catchy Subtitle)

Write your one paragraph only here describing your educational and professional experience as well as ecumenical and interreligious involvement, if any. Your essay will be evaluated on the basis of quality, not length. Use Times New Roman font size 12.

### Second Subtitle (Give a catchy Subtitle)

Write your one paragraph minimum here about major environmental, economic, social, cultural, civil, and political problems and conflicts in your country and community here. Your essay will be evaluated on the basis of quality, not length. Use Times New Roman font size 12.

### Third Subtitle (Put a catchy subtitle)

Write at least one paragraph of the recommended solutions to the problems and conflicts you have cited about. Use Times New Roman font size 12.

### Fourth Subtitle (Think of a catchy Subtitle)

State your motivation to work as an ambassador of peace. Write your one paragraph minimum here about what you, as an individual, plan to do concretely upon returning to your home country to address one problem. You will be required to implement a simple but doable action plan related to a volunteer community project of your choice that contributes to just peace. You can write anywhere from four paragraphs minimum to a total of six pages maximum, including references, for your whole essay. Note that the length of the paper is not an indicator of the quality of the paper. Persons selected to attend the program will have their essays compiled and included in the Training Manual that will be published as hardcopies and a PDF softcopy which will be distributed. Use Times New Roman font size 12. Remember to change the filename.
