### Invitation



#### Role of Host Churches/ Organizations Taiwan

- 4. Youths and young adults who want to know more about Taiwan.

#### **Expenses**

- Local expenses, during July 4 July 19, will be fully supported by PCT, local host churches and organizations. The expenses includes food, accommodation, accident insurance, transportation, and program.
- 2. Participants will be responsible for all other expenses: International air fare and other expenses in Taiwan, e.g. Laundry, telephone, medical insurance, and extended travel in Taiwan, etc


